Friendly Reminders:



- Swimmers who use the pool absence of a lifeguard do so at their own risk. Swimmers must leave the water upon request of a lifeguard.
- The lifeguards on-duty are in charge of the pool and have authority to remove anyone violating the pool rules or otherwise endangering the safety of any person.
- Appropriate swimwear is required at all times. Swimwear is permitted only in the pool area and the pool locker rooms, not the Clubhouse.
- Infants and toddlers must wear diapers secured by waterproof pants or swim diaper in pool.
- All Members and guests must register with the attendant before entering the pool area. Failure to register may result in loss of swimming pool privileges. Members will be charged a \$5 fee for guest use. Members are responsible for accompanying their guests at all times.
- Members bringing guests to the pool are limited to six guests. If bringing more than six guests, Members will need to call the catering department in advance to request availability.
- All children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times when in the pool area. No child under the age 18 may use the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty or unless accompanied by an adult.
- Parents or another adult responsible for the child must be present in the pool area and must appropriately supervise their children under the age of 10.
- All children under the age of five must be accompanied and supervised at arm's length by a responsible adult when in the main pool and baby pool (if the child is in the water, the adult MUST be in the water).
- Running, wrestling, pushing, dunking, "rough-housing" and towel-snapping are not permitted anywhere in the pool area.
- Snorkels, fins, kickboards, weights and flotation devices are not permitted in the pool unless permission is obtained from the pool manager.
- Swimmers in the deep end of the pool must be capable of swimming the length of the pool without assistance.
